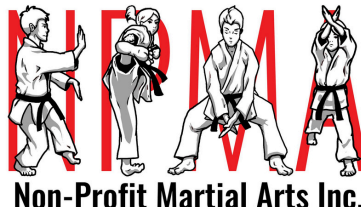

TOURNAMENT & EVENT RULES



BEGINNER & KARATE KID PROGRAM DIVISION GUIDELINES

- Beginner & Karate Kid Program Students will gather at 9:45 am and go with their instructors to the presentation area.
- Each Beginner & Karate Kid Program Student will be called to present a set of karate techniques of their choosing, punching, kicks, etc.
- A coach will assist each participant as needed
- Please wait patiently for your turn.
- Watch the other participants and learn from them
- Please let the coach know if the participant needs to leave for any reason

BOARD BREAKING GUIDELINES

- Participants will take turns hitting to break a board with a karate technique with either hand or foot.
- Karate instructors will coach each participant on how to hit the board and which karate technique that would be most suitable for the participant.
- Participants or their guardians must inform the karate instructors of any injuries.
- Tallack Martial Arts Students have learned the moves in class, this is a chance to exert force.

EACH MATTED TRAINING AREA IS 8 X 8M OF MATS CALLED A RING.

DIVISIONS MUST BE STRUCTURED BY LEVEL/ EXPERIENCE, AGE, WEIGHT/HEIGHT AND GENDER FOR FAIR PLAY AND INJURY PREVENTION.

PARTICIPANTS ARE JUDGED ON TECHNICAL AND ATHLETIC PERFORMANCE.

IN SPARRING EVENTS, EACH MATTED TRAINING AREA WILL HAVE 1 REFEREE, 2 OR 4 CORNER JUDGES, AND 1 OR 2 SCORE KEEPERS.

FOR SPARRING, COMPETITORS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR MOUTH GUARDS, FOAM DIPPED HELMET, GLOVES, AND BOOTS. NO JEWELRY OR WATCHES ARE PERMITTED.

NO CONTACT FOR COMPETITORS AGED 14 AND BELOW OR BEGINNERS/INTERMEDIATES OF ANY AGE.

LIGHT TOUCH BODY CONTACT FOR 14-YEAR-OLD+ ADVANCED COMPETITORS IS PERMITTED. LIGHT TOUCH TO THE HELMET IS REQUIRED.

NO CONTACT BELOW THE BELT OR THE FACE WHERE THE HELMET DOES NOT COVER.

SCORES ARE AWARDED FOR DISTANCE, TIMING, TARGETING, KIME/FOCUS, STANCES.

PROHIBITED BEHAVIOUR - EXCESSIVE CONTACT, POOR SPORTSMANSHIP RESULTS IN DISQUALIFICATION.

ALL COMPETITORS AND THEIR GUARDIANS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR SEEKING CLARIFICATION FROM THEIR COACH ABOUT ANY RULES THAT ARE IN THE ABOVE OR LATER ADDED AS REQUIRED.

OUT OF PROVINCE COMPETITION REGISTRANTS MUST PROVIDE VERIFICATION OF INSURANCE COVERAGE FROM THEIR SPECIFIC CLUB/ASSOCIATION PRIOR TO COMPETING.

ALL ATHLETES COMPETING MUST COMPLETE THE APPROPRIATE WAIVER FORM & BY COMPLETING THE FORM, ATHLETES TAKE FULL RESPONSIBILITY AND CERTIFY THEY ARE FIT TO COMPETE.

COMPETITION AREA MUST BE UNOBSTRUCTED BY SPECTATORS, COMPETITORS, JUDGES/REFEREES AND COACHES.

IN THE EVENT OF A SERIOUS ACCIDENT/INJURY, THE TOURNAMENT MEDICAL PERSONNEL MUST FILE A COPY OF THEIR INJURY REPORT WITHIN SEVEN (7) DAYS OF TOURNAMENT COMPLETION.
